

What to Pack Spring Snow Goose Hunting Highland

- Passport (essential)
- Field bag for shells etc.
- Renting Gun from Us – Pack approved Non-Resident Firearms Borrowing License in your carry-on bag (essential)
- Bringing Own Gun – Pack pre-approved Non-Resident Firearms Declaration Form RCMP GRC 5589 in your carry-on bag (essential)
- Bringing Own Gun - Shotgun, chokes (essential)
- Bringing Own Gun – Locking Gun Case for airline travel
- Warm waterproof camo jacket, bibs/coveralls or insulated pants, hat, gloves (essential)
- Camo & white balaclava type face mask (very important necessity)
- 3-4 Disposable Painter's Suits big enough to fit loosely overtop of your coat & bibs, etc. (very important necessity)
- Warm waterproof footwear (insulated, knee high rubber boots are excellent!)
- Undershirts, t-shirts, long sleeved shirts, long underwear, socks to wear in layers for warmth
- Shoes for inside lodge & garage (important)
- Duck & goose calls
- Travel coffee mug
- Camera (extra batteries)
- Cell/Tablet, cord, & charger block
- Non-Medical face masks if required by any airlines you are flying with
- Proof of Vaccination if required at time of travel to U.S. or Canada
- Uploaded travel app on cell phone if required at time of travel to U.S. or Canada
- If bringing a dog from U.S., bring a certificate of health for dog

White suits and a balaclava type face mask are a necessity! This is more important than bringing camo. We often hunt in pea and lentil fields with little ground cover. Layout blinds sometimes stand out making it more effective to wear white and try to blend in with the geese rather than to try and look like the ground. Wearing white is often better than camo should you get caught out of your blind with birds approaching. All the birds we hunt are accustomed to feeding with white geese here so we may even do this while hunting ducks and dark geese. White coverings that work are disposable painters' suits, butcher coats or snow camo. The balaclava type facemask that you can see through and shoot with is extremely important. **Please remember to bring this.**
